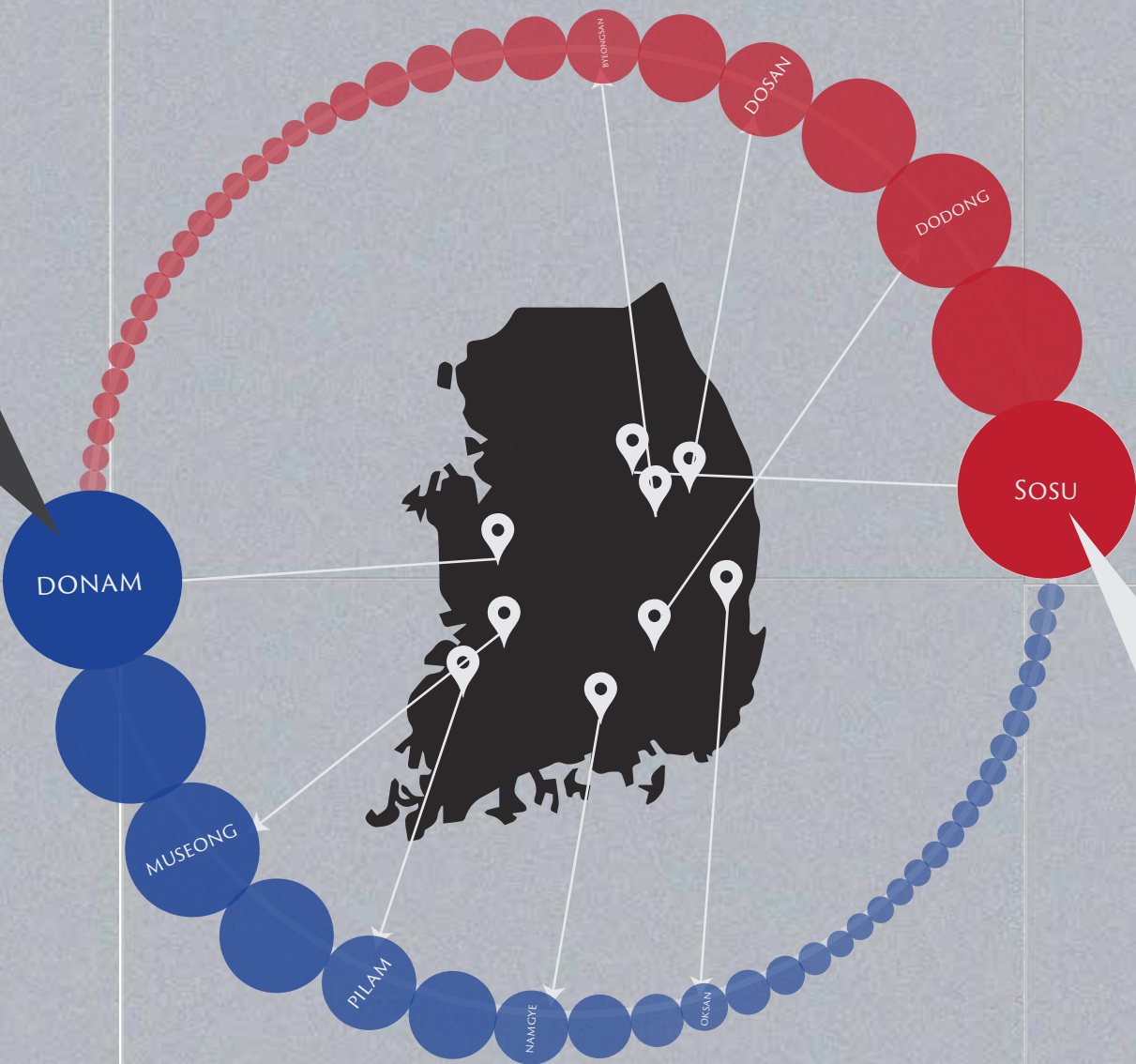


PRESERVERENCE

This means tourists can view these seowons with ease and view them in a day back to back. Just keep in mind to respect the history and be mindful of the signs meant to protect the property.

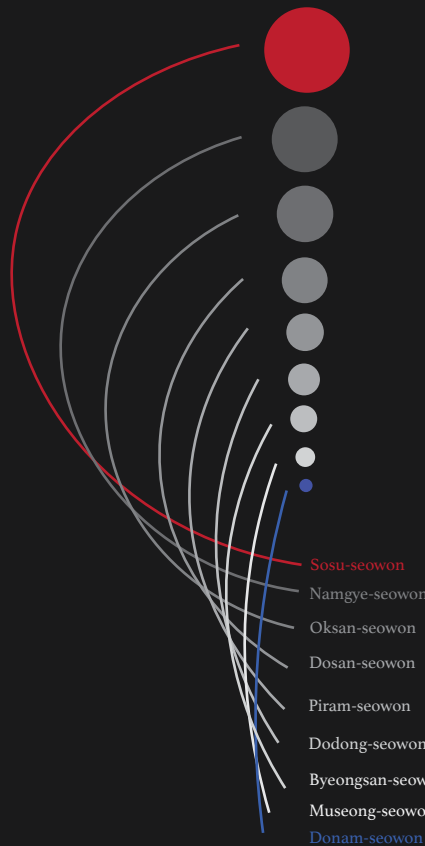

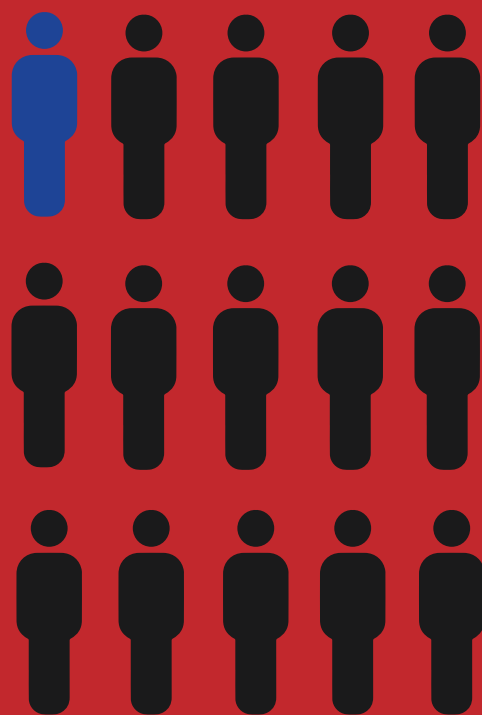
The most popular tourist attraction has been the Donam-Seowon while the second runner up has been found to be Sosu-Seowon.

PROPORTION TO TOTAL VISITORS IN SOUTH KOREA

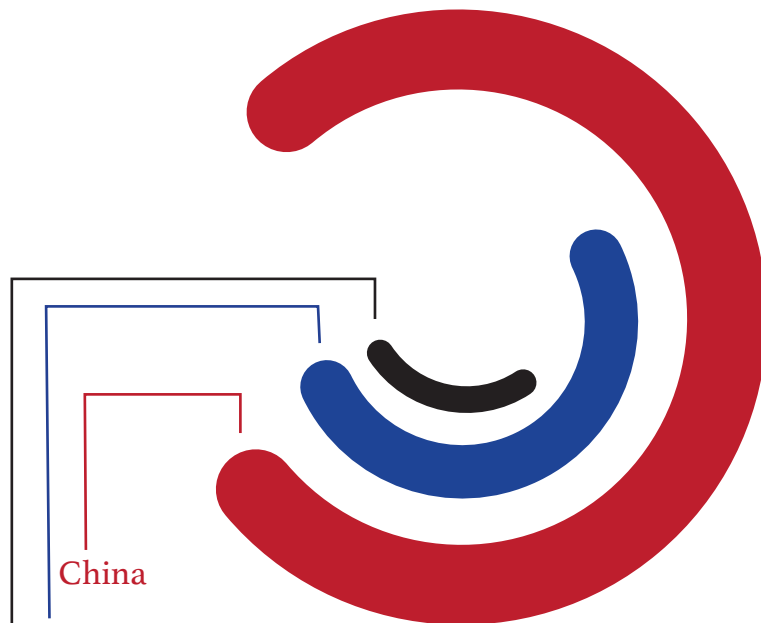
Every year more than 800,000 tourists visit South Korea, and most international tourists visit at least two UNESCO protected historical site.
