Neo-confucian academy that is visited in conjunction with Sosu-seowon. According to past visitors, it is a short detour driving between Baekje locations.


This seewon is very close to the main road so it is easy to get to. There are highly developed public transportation near the East coast line of Museong, Pilam, and Namgye-seewons.




The most popular tourist attraction has been the Donam-Seowon while the second runner up has been found to be Sosu-Seowon.
